



Confirmation of tail status of imported australian shepherd dogs with long tail

Procedure:

- This confirmation is only applicable for dogs with long tail. Dogs with bobtail must be DNA-tested (further info at www.nkk.no)
- The examination of the tail and confirmation of tail length must be performed by a veterinarian, or a conformation judge authorized for Australian shepherd.
- Fill in the dog/owner part of the form, and bring the form to the veterinarian or judge doing the examination.
- The form must be signed and sent to the NKK together with the other registration papers of the dog, for registration in the NKK.
- It is not mandatory that the confirmation is written in this particular form. If another layout is used, please make sure that all the information we ask for below is included.
